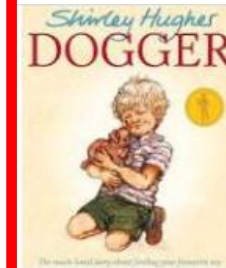


HA'WAY THE LADS!
