English:

Finally, we will recap the main features of the year 2 grammar curriculum and begin to introduce the year 3 curriculum.

Geography:

This half term we will use a digital/computer mapping to locate local area being studied and describe features studied, compare to aerial photo of same area. We will also use the 8 points of a compass to describe places relative to each other.

Art:

In Art, we will use a sketchbook to record observations. We will also use different types of lead pencil to scribble and shade.

<u>D&T:</u>


In D&T we will be looking at the skill of sewing. We will begin to introduce the backstitch and look at joining two materials together.
