We will be using the novel The Iron Man to inspire our work this half term!

Science:

In science we will be looking at forces and magnets this half term.

We will be comparing how things move on different surfaces. We will notice that some forces need contact between two objects. We will observe how magnets attract or repel some materials and we will predict what will happen using the pole of the magnet. We will also compare, group and identify magnetic and non-magnetic materials. We will use a range of equipment to gather and record from simple experiments and we will report our findings.

English:

This half term, we are going to be inspired by Ted Hughes' Iron Man. We will explore different text types including setting descriptions, character descriptions and a newspaper report to inform readers all about the iron man.

Reading - we will develop positive attitudes to reading and understanding of what we read.

We will increase the legibility, consistency and quality of our handwriting.
