We will be using the novel 'Where the Mountain meets the Moon' to inspire our work this half term!

Science:

In science we will be looking at light.

We will recognise that we need light to see and that light is reflected onto surfaces. We will learn about the sunlight and how shadows are formed. We will record our findings in bar charts and tables.



R.E:

In RE we will look at the question 'What do Hindus believe God is like?'

English:

This half term we are going to be inspired by the story 'Where the Mountain meets the Moon' by Grace Lin. We will explore writing different text types including: setting descriptions, character descriptions and a retell of the story.

In reading, we will be developing our positive attitudes to understanding what we have read in order to predict and summarise the text. We will be working on increasing the legibility, consistency and quality of our handwriting. We will also be learning how to develop our writing using fronted adverbials, speech and conjunctions.

History:

This half term, we are going to be learning all about the Shang Dynasty and use our enquiry skills to explore its culture and impact upon the wider world.
