
Year 4

THE DARK AGES

English:

Maths:

This half term we will be focusing on division, specifically learning how to use the short division method and long division. We will then be focusing on line graphs and tables to collect and represent data.

Science:

We are going to investigate:

- how sounds are made and how they travel to our ears.
- patterns between pitch and volume.
- how distance affects sounds and how sounds can be insulated.
- making our own string instruments.

History:

In History, we are going to explore the mighty Anglo-Saxon invaders and the period of time known as the Dark Ages. Our study will include learning about where they came from, why they invaded, what they believed in, how they lived, the impact that they had on England during their settlement and how we know about them.
