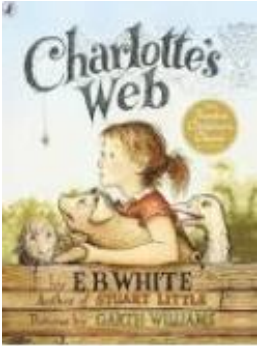


Year 4



Art:

In this half term in art we will be printing on fabric. We will increase our awareness of mono and relief printing.

Science:

In science we will be focusing on Electricity. We will be identifying common appliances that run on electricity. We will be constructing a simple series electrical circuit, identifying and naming its basic parts, including cells, wires, bulbs, switches and buzzers. Identifying whether or not a lamp will light in a simple series circuit, based on whether or not the lamp is part of a complete loop with a battery. We will be recognising that a switch opens and closes a circuit and identifying common conductors and insulators.

Personal Development:

During personal development this half term we will be focusing on RSE through the Yasmine and Tom Programme.

Charlotte's Web

This half term we will be inspired by the classic novel Charlotte's web.

RE

During our R.E topic this half term we will be asking the key question 'What does it mean to be a Hindu in Britain today?'

History

During history this term we will be learning about the Vikings. We will be asking the key questions-

- Why did Vikings invade Britain?
- What happened in Lindisfarne in 793?
- Why did Alfred sign a treaty with Guthrum?
- Were the Vikings the first Europeans to discover the Americas?
- Who were the Norse Gods?
- Did King Cnut try to stop the tide from coming in?

English:

In English, we will be inspired by the book Charlotte's Web by E.B White. We will be writing a setting description and a letter to complain to Mr Arable!

Maths:

In maths we will be focusing on decimals, money and time.
