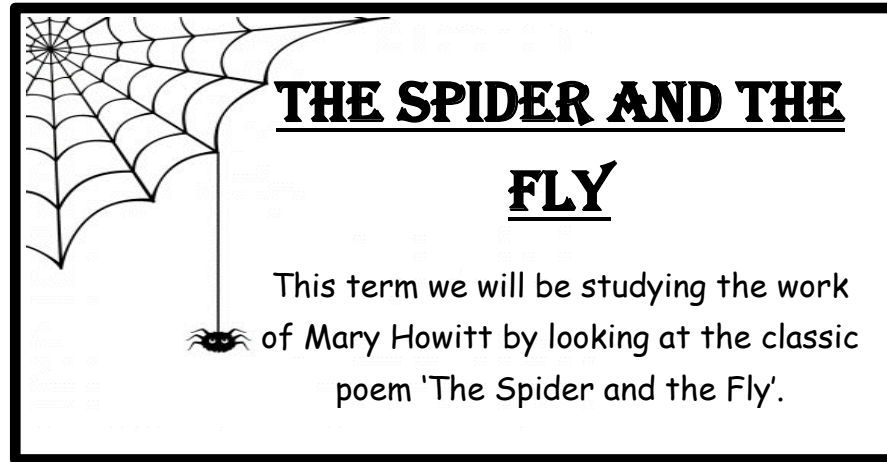


History

This term in History we will be studying the Middle East. We will start by considering why the Middle East is important to different religions. Then, we will find out all about the Ottoman Empire, including where it began and why it was successful. We will explore how conflict can leave a lasting impression upon the world and what effects past conflicts have had upon this region.

Art:

In art, we will be working with Alyson, our resident artist, to create pictures through a range of mono print techniques. We will gain experience using a range of media and experiment by overlaying colour.



Personal Development:

During personal development this half term, we will be focusing on RSE through the 'Yasmine and Tom Programme'.

PE:

In PE, children will learn to perform dance actions with control and expression. They will look to choose their own dance steps and movements, and then develop them into a longer routine.

English:

During this half term, our writing will be based around the poem 'The Spider and the Fly'. We will begin by writing a formal letter of complaint as a dear friend of the fly. We will then write a balanced argument.

Maths:

This half term in maths we are going to be looking at decimals and percentages. We will learn how to convert fractions to decimals, order and compare decimals with up to 3 decimal places and write percentages as both fractions and decimals.

RE:

In RE, we will be exploring a range of Biblical texts and Christian ideas in order to reflect on what it means for Christians to believe that God is holy and loving.
